OUTERLIMITS MIAMI BOAT SHOW 2007 LINE UP – BIG, FAST AND NO LIMITS

Outerlimits Powerboats cruises into Miami, leaving everyone in its wake. Sheer size and power are evident at booth #3330 at the Convention Center and at dock #210 at Sea Isle Marina & Yacht Center, where Outerlimits will display 46'-51' powerboats that exude grace, gumption and go-fast glamour.

50' CAT (Brand new addition to line. See attached press release)

51' GTX

Debuting at the Miami International Boat Show, this sit-down powerboat is the equivalent of a high-performance sports car on water. A low profile and high-horsepower twin staggered engines produce the precise handling that make a GTX *THE* ideal Poker Run boat for those serious about performance.

But *fun* is still the operative word as a dual helm accommodates one or two-person operation and race-type, sit-down, bolster buckets in back easily seat three more passengers in comfortable safety. Available in full or quarter canopy, flexibility is an added option for 39', 42' or 47' models. A variety of power options are available; the Miami International Boat Show model boasts top performance style with Mercury Racing SCi 1075 engines and a full canopy with removable lids and storage system.

This show model also sports a "Factory Billet" design scheme that includes a wide array of solid CNC'd billet accessories in the interior, engine compartment and even featured *in* the intricate metallic paint scheme by Dean Loucks at The Art of Design (TAOD). Nine *hundred* pieces of diamond plate are replicated throughout and as an added custom feature, the code used for the CNC finish of the billet is incorporated into the paint. Over 3,500 pieces of art, all in reds, silvers and metal flake, cover the deck and hull, giving the appearance of a metal boat, cut from a girder of solid aluminum.

The boat was built for a dedicated powerboat enthusiast as a billboard for his custom billet business, which includes a package of accessories made exclusively for Outerlimits. "I want to be affiliated only with leaders in the field," says Jim Schultz, owner of the 51 GTX, "My company uses the top technology in aluminum and Outerlimits is the equivalent in engineering boats. Dean captured that top-of-the-line look in this paint job—and wait until you see the matching truck—it is totally custom and will be ready to roll soon!"

47' GTX

This Outerlimits model was selected by Mercury Racing Team to showcase the newest and highest horsepower Mercury Racing engines to date, the 1200 SCi's. Like all GTX models, the 47' enjoys the spacious cabin and cockpit of the 9' 3" beam, as well as canopy options. This model, with Lamborghini look, painted in brilliant reds with camel tan interior, has its main attraction in the engine compartment, which was meticulously finished to accommodate the twin, Mercury Racing 1200's. Described by Mercury Racing as "...docile around docks and ferocious once unleashed..." the 1200's run on high octane race fuel. "Think of it as a street legal race engine," says Mercury. "Our customers are very speed savvy," says Outerlimits president, Mike Fiore, "It was natural for us to work with Mercury Racing as they fine-tune their highest-performing marine engines—we're happy to see them pushing the bar."

51' Sport Yacht

Power and luxury are mutually inclusive in the Outerlimits 51' Sport Yacht. One-of-a-kind customization ensures that every amenity in the boat suits the high expectations of its owner. The air-conditioned cabin has stand-up head room, the finest leather upholstery, exotic wood trims, a large flat-screen TV, entertainment system and galley. Comfortable lounge seating, a large V-birth, recessed lighting and a private spacious and well-appointed head and shower provide the luxury expected in a full-sized yacht.

But, this model also satisfies the Need for Speed! Sterling 1500 HP engines (capable of even more horsepower), with Mercury #6 drives, can carry this vessel through rough or calm water without disturbing any of the amenities below, and at astonishing speeds. Described as "The pinnacle of offshore performance," by a speed aficionado, this show model was created for Lake Cumberland Marine as a salute to former National and World Champion Racer and speed record holder, "Planet Man." The new Art of Design paint scheme incorporates the racy Planet Man Lamborghini yellow in candy, pearls and metallic paints and is carried from the body of the boat, to the detailed dash and even to the sculpted carpets.

The technologically sophisticated dash and lushly upholstered bolster seating offer comfort above as well as below. With plenty of room for friends and family aboard this 9'3" beam boat, the 51' Sport Yacht is ready to travel and is water-filled vacation, just waiting to happen.

46' LTD.

The perfect sized boat to jaunt from town-to-town or dock-to-dock, the 46' LTD is a new model to accommodate the literal growth of Outerlimits. Since customers continue to request bigger, faster boats, Outerlimits created the 46 LTD to upsize from the 39' Quattro and 42' Legacy. The 46' LTD offers the size to accommodate more power, bigger water and longer distances in safe and comfortable style--all through the innovative 5-step active ventilated hull, carbon fiber deck and double-core bottom. Light, strong, solid and rattle-free, like all Outerlimits Powerboats, the 46' LTD perfects offshore performance.

The large cockpit with a 9' 2" beam, has side-by-side, stand up bolsters with electric seat bottoms. The third, removable front bolster seat is an Outerlimits exclusive that enables more friends to join in the fun. The back bench seat easily seats four and storage space is abundant, discreetly tucked behind zippered upholstery. The bilge offers extra storage for the anchor and push-pin-attached fenders. While those above enjoy the wind and water, a smoothly rolling cabin door gives guests below privacy, comfort and quiet to enjoy the flat screen TV, sophisticated sound system, luxurious leather couches, lacquer-finished sink and icebox and subtle lighting. The private stand-up head and shower with sliding pocket door is an amenity not generally seen in like-sized boats.

Outerlimits Multiplex Power Management system facilitates operation of all electrical devices on board—a real advantage for those who prefer the ease of visual touch-screen technology to switches and panels. A back-up battery protects programming.

The high-stakes, city skyline paint theme of this Outerlimits, created by Hideaway Marine's designer and interpreted by The Art of Design, is ideal for the Poker Run crowd, featuring 3-D looking poker chips, custom carved carpets and glittering paint throughout. Upholstery is color-coordinated, as in all Outerlimits Powerboats, to carry the theme from deck to cabin.
