Fastest V-bottom in the Shootout History

Lake of the Ozarks, MO – August 24, 2003 – Outerlimits breaks another record as *the* fastest v-bottom in the history of the Lake Rescue Shootout. In this year’s Shootout, held in the Lake of the Ozarks Missouri, Outerlimits managed to come in first in four separate classes with four different boats. This year’s rule change, whereby the runs were done from a dead stop (not the running starts of the past), made the speeds attained by the Outerlimits boats even more amazing.

At a mind-blowing 138 mph, Bob Russell, along with Mike Fiore, president of Outerlimits, set a new record in Russell’s 42’ GTX as the fastest v-bottom in the Shootout history. The Outerlimits GTX was in class VF5P2.

Rusty Rahm, in his fully loaded 51 Outerlimits Sport Yacht took the trophy in the V6P2 class, clocking in at 108 mph. Husband and wife team, Ken and Karen Trelfa won their class, V5P3, in their 42’ Outerlimits complete with a full cabin and amenities. And in the V4P2 class, Keith Kasch won in his 37’ Outerlimits.

The Lake Rescue Shootout is the largest unsanctioned boat race in the Midwest. Sponsored by the fire departments in the Lake of the Ozarks, it is an annual event that becomes bigger and better every year. The Shootout started in 1988 as an event in which many local boats participated simply to establish who had the fastest boat. As the years progressed, the event

attracted entrants from all over the country trying to establish who is the top gun. Well, this year it was Outerlimits who can claim the fame with four outstanding boats.
