Outerlimits Releases Officially Licensed ‘XXX’ GTX

Bristol, RI – October 17, 2005. Outerlimits is pleased to announce that their 47’ canopied GTX. ‘XXX’ is now available in an officially licensed model. The 47 GTX was the first v-bottom to eclipse the 160 MPH barrier in an officially sanctioned event. The GTX was powered by twin stock 1450 HP Sterling engines with No. 6 Merc Speedmasters and Hering propellers. Mike Fiore, president of Outerlimits Powerboats, averaged a speed of **161.29 MPH** for a kilometer verified on ‘state-of-the-art’ GPS in February of 2004, in a certified speed trial, sanctioned by the National Powerboat Association,

State of the art computational fluid dynamic (CFD) techniques are used in the actual boat as well as the model. A contour plot of calculated pressures around the rear of the real boat illustrates the scientific detail involved. Dr Loo Yap, president of MHZusa, has been involved in improving the hydrodynamic and aerodynamic designs of Outerlimits Powerboats.

In a unique union of the real-boat and model-boat worlds, Outerlimits and MHZusa have officially licensed GTX XXX, offered as a RTR with MHZ’s new Twin 2 x 26cc Blue Line gas engine. The MHZ GTX will use a splitter gearbox and, similar to the original, two counter-rotating Speedmaster S6 drives. The GTX is modeled from detailed laser scans made from the world-record setting mono hull. The MHZ model will include high-quality graphics designed from the color codes of the original.
